

Meaningful Use Stage 2 (MU2) CCR Cancer Data Transmission Options

Secure FTP Transmission

- Request access to the Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) service by sending a request to <u>MU2CCRHelp@ccr.ca.gov</u> - with subject of 'SFTP Access' and stating the reason for the access in the body.
- 2. A User ID will be provided by email and a password will be provided over the phone.
- 3. Next, using any software that supports SFTP (for example, FileZilla; (http://filezilla-project.org/), configure your ftp connection with the information as provided below:
 - a. Host use: sftp://199.47.178.90.
 - b. Username and Password use the credentials support assigned to you.
 - c. Port '53216'
- 4. Once connected you will have write access to the MU2 folder on the CCR server and may upload your data per the HL7 CDA requirements.

NOTE: Users will only have write access to the MU2 folder. No other permissions are granted.

PHINMS Transmission

- Use the Public Health Information Network Messaging System (PHINMS) Software Request Form by going to the url: http://www.cdc.gov/phin/tools/phinms/quick-steps.html, and install the application per the directions on the web page.
- 2. Create the root information for California, using the information supplied below:



3. Encrypt and send the payload with the following Public Key Information (PKI).



4. Once connected you will have *write* access to the MU2 folder on the CCR server and may upload your data per the HL7 CDA requirements.
